## **New internal audit director named at SWIB**

Madison, WI (January 26, 2005) – Brandon M. Duck has been named internal audit director by the State of Wisconsin Investment Board (SWIB).

His duties include conducting reviews of the organization's risk management systems, accounting and administrative internal controls, performance measurement processes and calculations, and investment policy compliance.

Before joining SWIB, he was the audit manager at the University of Texas System Administration in Austin, where he was responsible for all audits of the University of Texas Investment Management Company, which invests \$16 billion for the UT system.

He has also worked as the chief financial officer/compliance officer of the Texas Treasury Safekeeping Trust Company in Austin and as an assurance manager and primary recruiter for investment management services at the public accounting firm of KPMG LLP in Chicago. Brandon received his bachelor's of science degree with a double major in accounting and finance from Eastern Illinois University in Charleston, Ill.

He is a certified public accountant, certified internal auditor, and certified investments and derivatives auditor.
