Duties: The Business Systems Analyst (multiple positions open) at State of Wisconsin Investment Board in Madison, WI will translate business requirements into technology specifications, and lead design and development of solutions to meet business needs. Collaborate with Technology Owners, Business Owners, and Operations to support current processes, research and implement new solutions, and facilitate and document prioritization of projects/enhancements and future projects/enhancements. Serve as architect and designer for investment management applications and systems SWIB utilizes, and how those applications, systems, and component pieces interact, including creating test plans, scenarios, and procedures for new software implemented. Coordinate with other areas to design, develop, and test solutions that will reduce errors, add functionality, and improve current processes. Implement software testing, using either manual or automated programs and exploratory testing, and evaluate results, including documenting and reporting defects or problems with software and oversee future maintenance and upgrades. Identify gaps and risks in the company's architecture and make recommendations that will address risks and make systems more supportable. Telecommuting permissible up to two times per week.

Requirements: Master's degree in Business Analytics, Finance, or a related field plus 3 years of experience as a business systems analyst, research analyst, management associate, or related occupation. Experience must include 2 years of experience with each of the following: (1) Investment instruments including Equities and Fixed Income; and (2) Bloomberg.
